2017 ORGAN DONATION AND TRANSPLANTATION OUTCOMES








In 2017, 1,402 Australians received a lifesaving transplant through the generosity of 510 deceased organ donors and their families who agreed to donation at the time of their loved one's death.

In 2017 the national program, which commenced in 2009, surpassed 10,000 transplant recipients.


